

Otty Lake 2019 Shoreline Planting Order Form

Thanks to the Rideau Valley Conservation Authority (RVCA) for their support in this initiative. In 2018 the RVCA revised the Tay River Subwatershed Report for Otty and the other lakes in the Tay watershed. As part of RVCA's Shoreline Planting Program, in the year following completion of a watershed report, RVCA provides plants at a significant reduction in price to the lakes in that watershed.



OLA is also subsidizing the cost of the plants we are offering this year, providing benefits to our residents in gratitude for your support. And if you aren't a member, we'd be happy to sign you up when you pick up your plants!

Otty Lake residents can buy the following plants at these prices:

- ***Trees in 1 gallon pots – FREE***
- ***Shrubs in 1 gallon pots - \$2***
- ***Wildflower plugs - \$2***

We are also providing fencing at cost (\$2.50 for 3 feet high by 3 feet long), to ensure that your plants have a chance to take hold and grow (and not be eaten).

To ensure as many residents as possible receive plants, we are limiting every household to purchasing a maximum of 5 wildflowers, and a combination of 5 trees and shrubs. Orders will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

Our plant order needs to be submitted early to allow time for our plants to be prepared/potted up for us so please respond as soon as possible.
