#### THE HYDRO CORRIDOR

The new route is not yet known, but plenty has been said about it at public meetings and by correspondence. Members of this Association have added their voices to those of the surrounding Townships in asking questions about the impact these lines and towers could have on the communities through which they are to pass. One of the possible routes would be parallel to the north shore of Otty Lake.

Speaking of hydro, those residents who would prefer to do their own brushing under the hydro right-of-way on their properties -- instead of letting Ontario Hydro do it with chemical herbicides -- may apply to do so. We will have application forms at the Annual Meeting.

Still the low, low price of \$5.00 per year per residence. You may pay at the meeting, or give it to your Area Counsellor at the next opportunity.


# Otty Lake good neighbours

#### JEBB'S CREEK LEVELS

Of all the 1,000 - odd residents of Otty Lake there must be at least a million opinions on the difference in elevation between the lake and theRiver Tay. In other words, how much drop is there in Jebb's Creek? We have heard many guesses: 2 feet, 5 feet, 9 feet and 1 foot. According to the surveyors for the Rideau Valley Conservation Authority, who ran levels the length of Jebb's Creek last fall, the difference that day was 31 inches.

As for the lake, residents will have noticed that the levels have fallen since the spring high. At June 18 the level was 4 inches below Datum (the average July 1 level of 1972-74). This appears to result, at least in part, from the removal of the dam and the clearing of Jebb's Creek as decided earlier by this Association. At a recent meeting, your executive decided to leave it for at least another year in order to obtain the cleaning benefit of the shoreline that was recommended by the Ministry of Natural Resources. We plan to review the matter again before the 1984 season.

# LIGHTFORD DEVELOPMENT

In June of 1980 we reported that the long negotiations with the developer and all the interested agencies was drawing to a reasonably satisfactory conclusion. The result can be summarized as 50 lots in a subdivision, set well back from the shore of Little Otty.

However, Dr. Lightford has recently approached the Council and the other agencies for permission to sell 9 shoreline lots as well. Your Association, on legal advice, has objected. We have several reasons for doing so, mainly because the proposal violates the 1980 agreement without the intensive study and consultation that the matter was felt to deserve and did receive then.

The Township of North Burgess has given its approval to 8 shoreline lots, and so has the Planning Board, but the Land Division Committee has not yet made a ruling.
