WATER SAFETY AND COURTESY

Speaking of boating, some boats do upset occasionally. Someone riding a windsurfer, for instance, or sailing a Laser may tip over but get upright again without any trouble. But sometimes the boater is having a more serious experience than that. If you happen to be near when a boat goes over, it might be a good idea to pull close and see whether help is needed or wanted.

And please, watch out for swimmers. We have already had one reported case of idiot boaters at high speed, much too close to swimmers in the water. It's no joking matter, as the OPP will gladly agree. It is a matter of common courtesy and good sense.

WATER LEVELS

Levels this year so far are keeping slightly above those of last year for equivalent dates. On June 16th the level was at the Datum line (the July 1 average level for 1972-75) and we expect slightly higher levels than last year for the 1984 season. Barring any unusual occurrences, your executive expects to continue the water regime recommended by the Ministry of Natural Resources for at least another year.
