2019-2023 Five Year Review

The OLA, in partnership with the RVCA's Shoreline Naturalization Program, has offered members of the community subsidized native trees and shrubs to be planted on the shores of Otty Lake.

Over the last 5 years, just over 1000 plants (1044) have been distributed to residents around Otty Lake since 2019.

On average 40 households received and planted each year.
